



# 1. Present Situation

In Doha, Qatar, negotiations have traditionally been conducted indirectly with Hamas representatives, most of whom are based there:

Israel: Mossad – David Barnea

USA: CIA – William Burns

Egypt: intelligence chief Abbas Kamal

Qatar: intelligence chief HE Khalfan bin Ali bin Khalfan Al-Batty Al-Kaabi.

These ceasefire negotiations have been unsuccessful because the Israeli government has repeatedly and openly stated that it reserves the right to:

1. Completely evacuate the Gaza enclave and expel all Palestinian residents, dead or alive. According to official ministerial statements, Israel no longer considers the Gaza population to be equal human beings, but rather animals, and even refers to babies as terrorists.

2. Completely disarm and destroy Hamas and assassinate all its officials.

In this situation, Hamas has been trying since 2023 to achieve a permanent ceasefire, guaranteed by Israel's most important arms supplier by far, the US. This is clearly not succeeding. Instead, it must be clearly stated that without the multifaceted support by the US in particular—but also by its allies Germany, France, and Great Britain— to Israel's army and secret services, the genocide in Gaza could have been ended as early as October 2023.

Announcements of possible future recognition of Palestine under international law by France and Great Britain do not help at all. Germany openly declares its fundamental support for the Israeli position, in a perverted form of misunderstood reparation for past Holocaust crimes.

Germany has so far built five nuclear-armed submarines for Israel, with the sixth due to be delivered this year, 2025. Confidential sources report that two of these submarines are stationed directly off the coasts of Russia and the US.

Meanwhile, since October 2023, Israel has been violating international humanitarian law in an extremely blatant manner and has tightened the illegal blockade of the Gaza enclave, imposed since 2007, to such an extent that only isolated deliveries are reaching the people.

The UN reports, as of mid-August 2025

- Hundreds of people in Gaza have already starved to death, most of them children; 10% of all children are at acute risk of starvation.

- 90% of the Gaza population is suffering from hunger at the two highest (disaster) levels, 4 and 5.

The Gaza Strip has always been supplied with electricity and water by Israel. Israel has completely cut off the electricity supply, destroyed or restricted the water supply, and reduced diesel deliveries to such an extent that even the



desalination plants, some of which have been deliberately destroyed, can hardly function anymore, let alone on a permanent basis.

The lack of diesel for generators has killed thousands of Palestinians because the deliberately destroyed hospitals can no longer operate their vital power generators. Israel's army also repeatedly destroys generators and does not allow replacement equipment into the Gaza Strip.

Instead of the proven distribution of goods by the highly professional, reliable, and impartial UN organization UNRWA and its internationally recognized, proven partners, a mixed Israeli-US mercenary organization, GHF, has been installed: "Gaza Humanitarian Fund," which has fallen into disrepute and come under severe criticism worldwide, and whose employees habitually and arbitrarily fire live ammunition into starving crowds. They kill dozens of people indiscriminately every day, with more than 100 deaths not uncommon, reaching a total of approximately 1,778 by August 11, 2025. They injure hundreds more starving people every day, reaching a total of 12,894 by August 11, and by mid-July, 42 of the waiting starving people had also been reported missing. These facts are causing storms of indignation worldwide.

In this situation, it seems crucially important that it finally becomes clear worldwide that Israel's policy of mass murder and/or genocide is not in the interests of Jewish people around the world, many of whom have been criticizing Israel's policy of oppression against Palestinians and Palestine, often for decades. That is why we, together with people all over the world, are calling for people of the Jewish faith and honest humanitarian convictions to finally be given the opportunity to talk to responsible leaders of the Hamas Politburo through their representatives and to reach an agreement. Both sides are ready to do so.

### **This agreement could look like this for Gaza – with US guarantees in each case:**

Step 1: Immediate permanent ceasefire with immediate complete opening of all border crossings for all food and humanitarian goods of all kinds, including diesel, huts and tents, generators and heavy clearance equipment, as well as materials for restoring civilian infrastructure: repair of pipelines, seawater desalination plants, hospital equipment.

Release of half of all living and dead Israeli and other prisoners in the Gaza enclave, gradually over 6 weeks.

Step 2: Peace settlement and complete, permanent end to the Gaza blockade with the right to exercise sovereign rights such as: construction and unrestricted operation of ports, as well as repair and commissioning of the EU-funded Gaza airport in the south of the enclave.

Release of the remaining living and dead Israeli and other prisoners in the Gaza enclave, gradually over a period of six months.



### **The West Bank also needs viable solutions NOW!**

Of course, an agreement must also be reached in the future for the West Bank, which is being increasingly brutally oppressed and abused by Israeli troops and aggressive illegal settlers – again with US guarantees. The fact that Israel has already carried out the planned annexation by naming it only shows its determination to break the law. This cannot be discussed as a matter of priority at present – due to the urgency of the humanitarian catastrophe caused by Israel's actions in the largely destroyed Gaza enclave – but the task remains: Withdrawal of all Israeli troops, repatriation of all (illegal) settlers to Israeli territory in a process lasting no more than five to ten years.
